

Garnet Gateau x Victorian

- No stitch
- 1** Roof, Outline, etc: DMC 3802 (Antique Mauve VY DK)
- 2** Shading: DMC 3803 (Mauve DK)
- House Exterior: DMC 962 (Dusty Rose MED)
- House Eaves/Light Brick: DMC 818 (Baby Pink)
- Dark Brick: DMC 3726 (Antique Mauve DK)
- ▲ Light Green Leaves (DMC 320)
- ▲ Dark Green Leaves/Ivy (DMC 3815)
- ▽ Flower A (DMC 552)
- △ Flower B (DMC 3766)
- ◀ Flower C (DMC 307)
- ▷ Flowerpot? (DMC 402)

Required Materials:

- Embroidery hoop (5" round should be fine)
- Even-weave/Aida cloth (if using pattern colors, I recommend Light Blue)
- Needle (14-count Aida: size 24 tapestry needle)
- Thread snips/small scissors
- Embroidery Floss (see below)
- Optional: needle threader, thimble, framing materials, fancy drink, etc.

Pattern Notes:

- Finished dimensions (14-count Aida): approx 2.5" wide by 3.5" tall
- 'Garnet Gateau' is single-thread backstitch; feel free to modify/omit
- Floss colors can be modified to your preference:
 - Flower A~C, Flowerpot: whatever you want/got on hand
 - Light Green, Dark Green: they're leaves, so...
 - Roof, House Exterior, Eaves: I recommend choices that visibly contrast
 - Roof, Shading: I've chosen two colors with a similar hue but a slight value contrast
 - Light/Dark Brick: same as above, but bigger value contrast
